

Travel Gadgets and Gear: The Transmover



Why pull a carry-on when there's one to carry you?

There's an unwritten rule of travel: the later you check in at the airport, the farther your gate will be from security. And even if you're a master of packing light, it's not fun racing through the airport dragging your carry-on behind you as you hear the boarding announcements for your flight.

Well, that's not quite true. It *wasn't* fun to race through the airport—until now. Because [The Transmover](#) isn't just another suitcase on wheels. It's a suitcase on a three-wheeled motorized scooter.

With its hand throttle switch and dual hand and foot brakes, this carry-on is fully equipped to be taken out for a test drive. And even when you have time to spare, it turns a trek through the terminal into a ride at the playground.

The exterior is constructed of aluminum alloy, the telescopic handle can be adjusted to your height and comfort preferences, and the rechargeable lithium-ion battery is easy to attach and detach. The Transmover folds easily when the scooter component is not in use, and it is approved for storage in the cabin.
